The scholarship, **based on financial need and student essay**, provides an opportunity for students to attend Civic Theatre School.

The Application

Application for a theatre school scholarship consists of the application form, documentation of financial need, and an essay from the potential student.

Deadline: three weeks prior to opening of each session (Monday)

Notification: applicant will be notified of receipt two weeks prior to opening of each session.

Eligibility

Students grades Pre-k through 12th grade

Application Essays

Please attach a response to the following questions. All responses should be typed or printed clearly. These responses must be the work of the student himself or herself. Parents may assist younger students (grades one through four) in formulating written responses.

- 1) Why do you want to attend Civic Theatre School?
- 2) What do you think you'll get from the program?

Financial Information

Parents/Guardians: Please attach a copy of your most recent IRS 1040 tax return form. If you wish, you may attach a written explanation of your current financial situation.

All applications must be received at Civic Theatre by 5 pm Monday, 3 weeks prior to the start of the session.
